

Nemuro Hide Map

Meiji Park Hide *Variable Open Hours

Birds to Meet: Long tailed rosefinch, Siberian rubythroat, Bush warbler, Great spotted woodpecker, Black-faced bunting, Goldcrest, Cuckoo, Chestnut-cheeked starling, or some kinds of Cincia.



Onnemoto Hide Open 24/7

Birds to Meet: Rock sandpiper, Falco rusticolus, Long-tailed duck, Surfduck, Harlequin duck, Red-breasted merganser, Asian Rosy Finch, Redpoll, Stonechat, Black-browed reed warbler, Middendorff's grasshopper warbler, and more.



Tobai Hide Open 24/7

Birds to Meet: Japanese crane, Whooper swan, Steller's sea eagle, White-tailed sea eagle, Black-browed reed warbler, Stonechat, Widgeon, Bluebill, or some kinds of ducks.



Cape Nosappu Hide *Variable Open Hours

Birds to Meet: Pigeon Guillemot, Spectacled Guillemot, Least Auklet, and some kinds of seabirds such as Crested Auklet (Sometimes you can meet Seal and Sea otter, too).



Forest of Citizen Hide Open 24/7

Birds to Meet: Great spotted woodpecker, Eurasian Jay, Jungle crow, Long-tailed Tit, Eastern crowned warbler, Wrens, Common redpoll, Hawfinch, Orlan, and more.



Hanasaki Port Kurumaishi Hide Open 24/7

Birds to Meet: Widgeon, Northern Pintail, Greater Scaup, Harlequin Duck, Surf Duck, Red-breasted Merganser, Pelagic Cormorant, Japanese Cormorant, and more. (Sometimes you can meet Sea Otter, too.)



Bettoga Hide Approx. 2h from Bettoga St.

Birds to Meet: Steller's sea eagle, White-tailed sea eagle, Black kite, Siberian rubythroat, Japanese bush warbler, Stonechat, Japanese snipe, Middendorff's grasshopper warbler, Gray's grasshopper warbler, and more.
